The text was written with specific structures and vocabulary guided by topics. The topics are mainly to teach certain information and culture of Thailand. Although the textbook is not classified as authentic material (written for Thai speaker directly), the authors used many types of structures and vocabulary similar to textbooks for native speakers learning Thai.

The textbook was written with classroom instruction for both speaking and reading purposes; it is not suitable for self-study without a follow-up session by the teachers. However, Thai language learners may benefit from the sound files accompanying each lesson.

Self study students can listen to the sound by clicking [Lesson 1](#)  under “Sound” column or just the text for reading under the text column [เดินทางเข้าเมืองไทย](#). Students can listen to the sound while reading along on the screen (or print out if desire). The pdf. file also allow learners to increase or decrease the size of the text .

Use the arrow on the top of the menu bar to navigate the text. The sound is open with your default program in your computer.
